

John: As I Have Loved You

Title: The Good Sheep

Passage: John 10:22-42



Read John 10:22-42

Is there something from either the passage or sermon that resonated with you in a new or memorable way?

Pastor Dwain began his sermon by stating that this passage speaks specifically to two things: **Who we are to Jesus and who He is to us.** *Spend some time as a group reflecting on the primary image of Shepherd and sheep from the last two sermons. Share your thoughts on the different things that come to mind.*

What does Jesus point to as the primary testament that what he says about himself is true? What is significant about the fact that the Jews around Him only seemed to respond in two ways: by believing Him or by attempting to stone Him?

A portion of the sermon had to do with the doctrine of eternal security (once belief in Jesus is professed a person cannot lose their salvation). **Re-read verses 28-29.** *Have you wrestled with this doctrine? If you have come to a position on it, share it with the group and tell them why.*

Close your time in prayer. Praise God for being our Good Shepherd that pursues us despite our failures. Thank Him for providing a way for us to listen, be known and follow Him. Ask God to help you keep your eyes open to ways He is working around you.
